Rave Commercial recently introduced its newest project, called Hamlin Plaza. It will be located at 5300 Hamlin Groves Trail in Winter Garden, and plans call for 40,000 square feet of retail, medical and office space across 4 acres.



December, there were more than 176,000 residents living in the Horizon West area. And with about 1,000 people moving to Orange County weekly according to county statistics, the number is expected to grow.

Hamlin Plaza developers said Rave Commercial chose to build in Hamlin, because it is the second fastest-growing master-planned community in the nation. The mixed-use development will sit west of Hamlin Groves Trail, south of New Independence Parkway and the Publix-led shopping plaza, and east of The t Hamlin.
